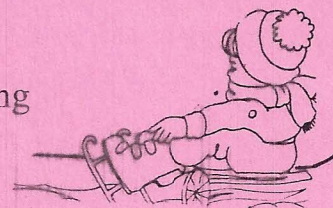

REMINDERS:

1. All children in Creative Garden School who wish to be enrolled in the school for September, 2013 *must* fill out a *new* application form and return it with the registration fee to the office. If you have questions concerning class availability, contact the office. *As always, thank you for your kind cooperation.*
2. Please note school policy: 2012/13 registration fees are non-refundable unless notification of family relocation is given prior to April 1, 2012.
